WHAT IS THE COLOR CORRIDOR? Before the 5K walk and run begins, there will be a Fun Run for kids (and adults who wish to participate). During this run, participants will run down the color corridor and be splashed, squirted and doused in colorful, water miscible, nontoxic paint! This will be a colorful and fun way to start off the 5K!

Participation in this fun run is OPTIONAL and undeniably fun!

This nontoxic paint will be handed out to registered participants who will form the color corridor for fun runners to run through! When the fun runners pass through the color corridor, the registered Color Splash Participants will get to good naturedly splash their color on those who pass through the corridor.

A FEW SUGGESTIONS...

- * **Wear Clothes you don't mind getting some paint on!** The paint is water-based and washes off for the most part, but some light paint marks will be left. Our test kids in our test run of the color corridor found the “post-washing machine results” to be quite wonderful additions to their play clothes. The color shows up best on white or light colored clothes, which we suggest for the best color effects. If color does get on unwanted places, we suggest washing clothes with an OxiClean (or similar) product.
- * **Sun glasses or swimming goggles are a suggested addition** to the fun run color corridor. The paint should be tossed only on shirts, but we would like to suggest this additional safety precaution and fashion statement! As with any substance, you want to try to avoid getting any paint in the eye area.
- * **Bring a beach towel, tarp, or change of clothes for the car ride home.** This paint is washable, but we don't want to take any chances with your car upholstery!
- **Cover cell phones/cameras/video cameras with plastic wrap** for protection from paint in the “Color Corridor” zone.
